


How To Access Microsoft Project for Students

 Clear the cache and cookies of the browser you are using. Within the Chrome app select More in the top right corner of your browser. Tap History, then select Clear browsing data. At the top, choose a time range. To delete everything, select All time. Next to "Cookies and site data" and "Cached images and files," check the boxes. Tap Clear data.


